An email will be sent to the email you provide us to give you your audition date. Your audition will only be 3-5 minutes. A CD player and tape player will be available. No accompanist will be available. You must provide your own music.

Each applicant, group or individual, if chosen to participate in the talent show will have to pay a \$10 dollar entrance fee. This means \$10 for a group act and \$10 for an individual act. If there are 10 of you in a group then the group only pays \$10. The talent show rehearsal is **mandatory** and will take place on **Friday evening, April 20th from 6 – 9:00 p.m.** with more details to follow in the future. The Waynesboro Talent Show will take place on **Saturday, April 21, 2012 at 7 p.m. at the Waynesboro High School Auditorium** with future details coming. Tickets will be \$5. CTC will award talents in certain age group categories. Those categories are Grades K-6th, Grades 7 – 8, and Grades 9 – 12. College students and adults in the community can participate if space is available but will not be awarded prizes.
